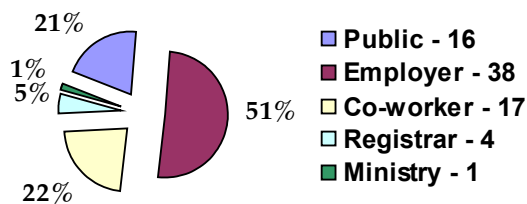


2010 Annual Report of the Investigation Committee

The Investigation Committee met for five (5) one day meetings, four (4) two day meetings and held two (2) teleconferences throughout the year.

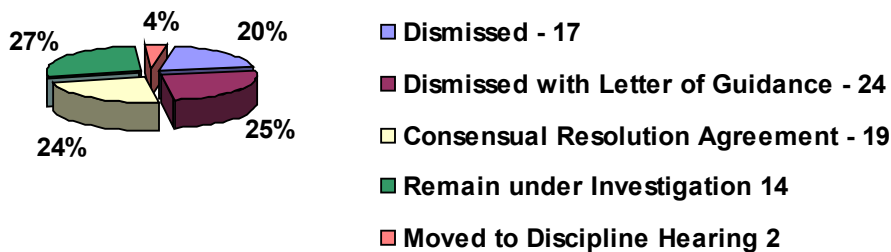
The Committee received 76 written reports concerning the professional conduct of registered members in the year 2010. Sixty-Six (66) reports related to the practice of Registered Nurses and four (4) related to the practice of Graduate Nurses. Six (6) reports received related to the practice of Registered Nurse (Nurse Practitioners). The chart titled "Source of Reports Received in 2010" indicates the distribution of reporting sources.

Source of Report Received in 2010

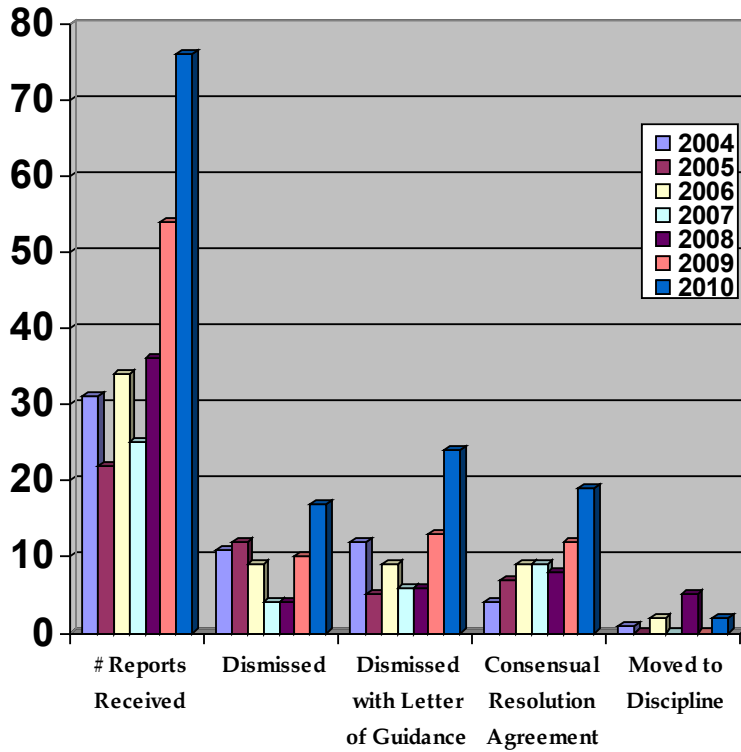


Of these 76 reports, seventeen (17) were dismissed, twenty-four (24) were dismissed and issued a Letter of Guidance, nineteen (19) were moved to Consensual Resolution Agreements. Two reports were moved to a Discipline Hearing in 2010. Fourteen (14) reports remained under Investigation into 2011.

Disposition of 76 Reports Received in 2010

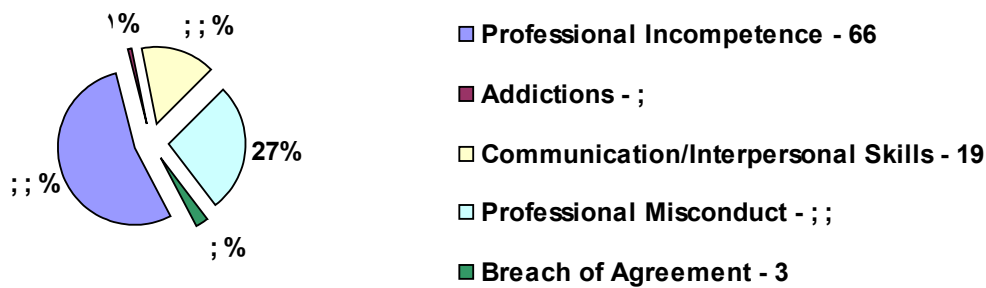


Disposition 2004 - 2010

Fourteen (14) cases carried over from 2009 were resolved. Of these two (2) were dismissed, four (4) were dismissed and issued a Letter of Guidance, eight (8) were moved to the Consensual Resolution Agreement Process.

Sixteen (16) of the Consensual Resolution Agreements developed in 2010 were related to the development and monitoring of appropriate assessment, needs identification,

outcome identification, planning and intervention skills; one (1) to the treatment of an addiction to narcotics; six (6) to poor interpersonal relationship skills; sixteen (16) to inappropriate documentation; one (1) to theft from the facility; one (1) to breach of confidentiality; one (1) to not following policies and procedures of the employer; three (3) to the member being unfit to practice; two (2) to patient abandonment; two (2) to practicing outside of scope and nine (9) to medication administration practices.

There are currently twenty eight (28) Consensual Resolution Agreements being monitored. Six (6) Consensual Resolution Agreements were completed in 2010.
